Or if you feel anxious about the state of the world and what the future looks like, the Dark Night will serve as a reminder that God continues to work even in our fear and discomfort.

Or maybe, you just want to spend an hour or so of your Christmas season with God. Praying, singing, listening, lighting candles, holding onto hope. Sitting in the comfort of our church sanctuary and remembering God's Christmas promise that we are never alone.

I know Thursday, December 12<sup>th</sup> is kind of a crazy time for a worship service. On the other hand, coming to the Dark Night service might wind up being one of the better things you do on your way to Christmas this year.


