- Someone who will faithfully meet with you on a weekly basis for as long as your need persists.

A Stephen Minister is NOT:

- A counselor or therapist;
- A problem-solver;
- Someone who runs errands or helps with chores; or
- A casual visitor.

Our Stephen Ministers are ready to provide you with the confidential, one-on-one Christian care you need to make it through a crisis or help you through a difficult time.
